## **SOCCER**

A somewhat disappointing outcome in registrations this year saw the number of teams fall from 26 last year to 22 this year, with an even more dramatic drop in registered players from over 400 to about 260. The bigger discrepancy in player numbers compared to the slight drop in teams was due to the fact that this year incorporated Under 9's into the Small Sided Games format, with a corresponding reduction in team sizes. We lost our Prem 1<sup>st</sup>'s and Reserves, plus last year's 15/1's, Grand Final-winning 16/3's and Senior 11's.

On a more positive note, Raff introduced an Introduction to Soccer program for Under 5's and received a great response, with over 20 keen, budding players signing up and going through their paces on the northern end of Field 1 on Saturday mornings. Hopefully this will give us a new base to build up numbers and teams in the future.

Unseasonably high rainfall in July and early in the season saw the postponement of several matches in Rounds 3 and 8 and complete washouts in Rounds 10 and 15. All matches in Rounds 3, 8 and 10 were rescheduled, but a decision was made to cancel Round 15 completely. A finals strategy is currently being formulated by Granville and should be available before next weekend, along with the venues to be utilized. With only one round left in the competition (plus a couple of catchup matches), most of our teams are doing quite well. Out of the 13 competition teams, 7 look almost certain to make it to the semis, with another 2 probable. A great effort! Curtis Oval has been nominated as one of the venues for both Mixed and Ladies' Semis, but this has not yet been confirmed.

Congratulations to our Under 9 Blues as one of 4 Granville Association teams selected to play at half-time in the Sydney FC/Parramatta FC trial game on 17<sup>th</sup> August. Hope to see as many Dundas supporters as possible at the game next week.

Dundas Sports Club has continued its generous sponsorship this year and we would encourage parents, friends and senior players who are not already members to join the club in appreciation of Dundas Sport's generosity. We will be holding our Senior Presentation night at the club and have plans for holding more social events next year.

Also thanks to all teams, parents, supporters and management for the great help they've again given in helping out in the canteen, setting up the nets, standing in as referees, officiating as Ground Officials, etc. I would particularly like to thank the coaches and managers for their efforts in training and administering the teams throughout the season.

Finally, very special thanks again to Margaret Earnshaw for her tireless efforts in supervising the canteen each week, and to her daughter Amy for her great support. Additionally, towards the end of this season, we started up the BBQ each Saturday to support the canteen sales. This proved to be a great success and special thanks go to Donna Scognamiglio, Rocky and Margaret for manning BBQ each week.

Greg Berriman, with the help of his sons, David and Thomas, again gave up hours of their time during the season marking the fields and our sincere appreciation go to them as well. ## **TREASURER'S REPORT**

### **FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2011**

It is with pleasure that I present the Profit and Loss and the Balance Sheet for the financial year ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2011.

The Club continues to be in a strong financial position after recording a surplus of \$3,819, (surplus of \$2,308 in 2010) which in turn takes the balance of our Club funds to \$92,367 (\$88,547 in 2010). It is the objective of the Management Committee to record slightly better than a break-even result each year in order to provide the Club with long term financial stability and to ensure the continued growth and development of our three sporting activities.

Congratulations and special mention must be made of our canteen manager, Margaret Earnshaw and all those who helped in the canteen throughout the year as the contribution from the canteen in relation to the Club's activities and financial return is Paramount to the Club's success. This year the Canteen contributed a surplus for the year of \$7,216 (surplus of \$6,005 in 2010). Also special thanks to our hard working gear stewards, Rocky Zappia in soccer and Kathy Scriven in Netball whose efforts are greatly appreciated.

As noted in the Profit and Loss statement income levels are down across all sporting activities due to the lower number of registered players, consequently expenses are also down in line with the reduced number of player.

The financial outcomes of the three sporting activities are shown in the Profit and Loss Accounts. Soccer recorded a surplus \$2,321, while Netball recorded a surplus of \$532 and Cricket recorded a deficit of \$2,853. Administration expenses include but are not limited to insurance, website maintenance, telephone, bank charges, audit fees and depreciation.

Congratulation to John Forbes, Cecilia Ommundson, Greg Berriman and their respective committees for the successful running of their individual sports.

A special thank you to Linda Zappia, for her efforts in assisting me in maintaining the books and accounts in an accurate and efficient manner.

In summary, the Club is in a strong financial position and we should look forward with confidence to the coming year.
